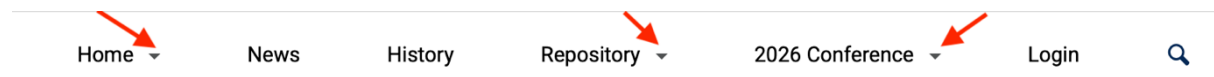

Website Overview.

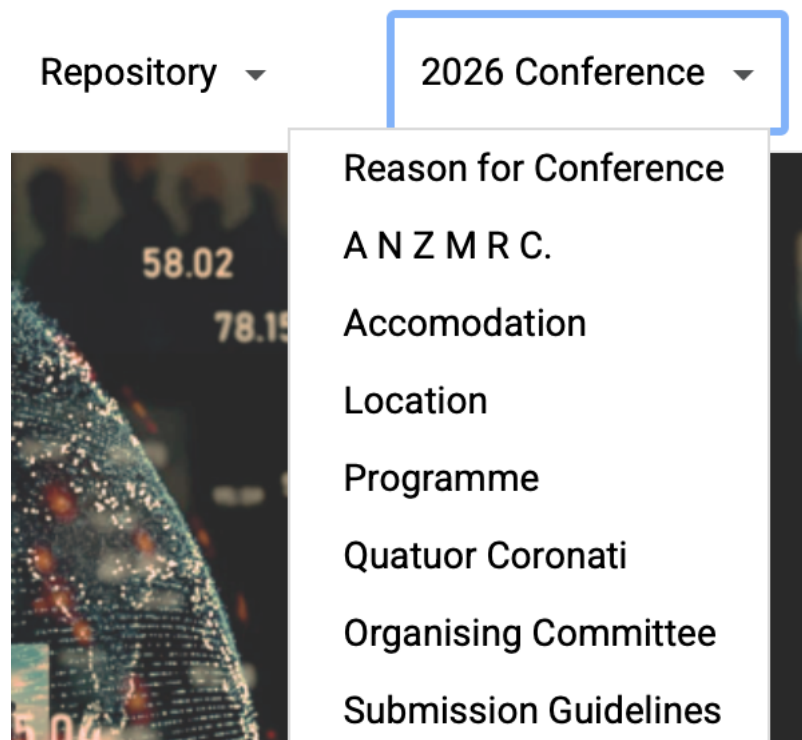
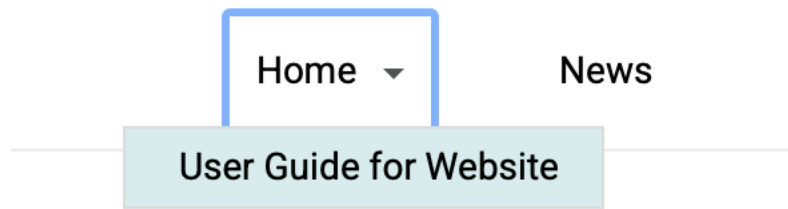


In the top right corner of the website, you will find the main navigation titles: (as above)

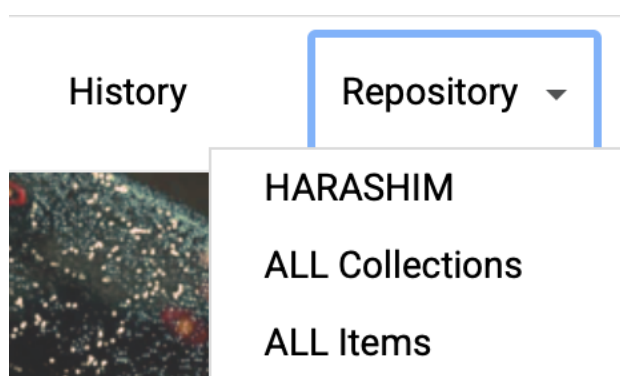
- Home: Navigate back to the homepage from any other section of the website.
- News: News Flash - What is happening – An area for any items of importance that may assist users – updated as and when.
- History: Explore the rich history of ANZMRC and its significant milestones.
- Repository: Access a comprehensive collection of research materials and publications – click below the red arrows to reveal further items.
- 2026 Conference: Find information about the upcoming 2026 ANZMRC Conference, including dates, venue, and registration details - click below the red arrows.
- **Login:** Sign in to access personalised features for **committee** members only who have the ability to upload content and change features (currently 6 at present).
- **Login:** Sign in to access personalised features for **contributing** members who have the ability to write and manage their posts, but their content needs approval before publishing.

- Search (Magnifying Glass Icon): Use this tool to search the website for specific content by entering keywords or names.

The Repository section is a crucial part of our website, housing a wealth of research materials.

When you click the inverted triangle (shown by red arrow) on the Repository title, a dropdown menu will appear, displaying the following options:

- HARASHIM: Publications and articles from the HARASHIM journal.
- ALL Collections: Browse through various collections of research materials.
- ALL Items: View all individual items available in the repository.

ALL Papers: Access a wide range of research papers, including those from The Victorian Lodge of Research, Top of the South, W H J MAYERS - Papers, Research Lodge of Otago, Hawke's Bay Research Lodge, Transactions of Sydney Lodge of Research, Research Lodge of Southland No 415, Toowoomba Lodge of Research and Instruction and other lodges that have given us authorization to publish their papers.

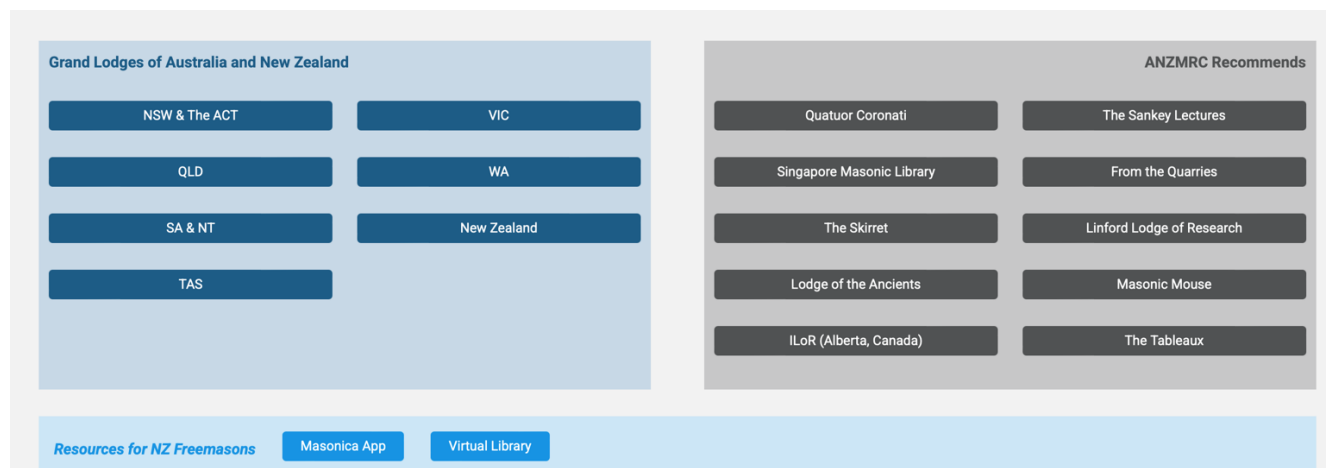
